What have sheep got to do with Easter Eggs?

Jesus tells a story about a shepherd who has one hundred sheep and loses one. He then leaves the 99 sheep to go and find the lost one. The story is about God's love for each and every one of us, no matter who we are.

Some of the sheep on the trail this year are BIG and others very small. They've been hand knitted by different members of our community, they're all pretty unique. And they've gone off in their own directions.

This story of Jesus is known as the Parable of the Lost Sheep. The word parable means "a story with a meaning", and the meaning of this story is this... we are all known and loved by God so much that he will never leave you on your own, no matter who you are, where you've come from, or whichever direction you've taken. Like the shepherd in the story he'll keep on searching to bring you home into his fold.

Eggs at Easter are a symbol of new life, which is the message Jesus told his friends, that if they put their faith in him, it is like being given new life.. a second chance; once we've been found by God, its our choice to live, love, and enjoy life being known and loved by him.
